Notes for THOMAS TRAMMELL:

The ancestoral seat of the Trammell family was in Nurenberg, Germany for many generations. By the thirteenth century, we find them in Enfgland.

The Trammell family came to England from France. Settled first in Devon and later Suffork, England

Notes for THOMAS TRAMMELL:

In the spring of 1671 Thomas sailed from Bristol, England to America.

He signed an agreement 5 March, 1674/75 to work for 4 years for Francis Wyeth.

At the end of that time, he was given 50 acres of land in the colony.

He eventually owned plantations in St Paul's and Overwharton Parishes, both in Stafford County. At that time, tobacco was brought to the Stafford ports for export.

Thomas died 1720/21.

About 70 gens old

His estate in Stafford County was probated in 1725/26

In the Minutes of the Council of the General Court of Virginia, dated March 5, 1674/75, page 405, is this entry: "Upon oath of Captain Moore that Thomas Trammell came to this country but for four years - It is ordered that he be acquitted from service and that Mr. Francis Wyeth, his master, do pay him coin (corn?) and clothes according to custom and costs".

Thomas settled in Stafford County, Virginia, and died there, as indicated by his estate record shown by the Index book to be in Will Book 1721-1730 (1750?), page 171.

The Will Book is lost but the Index Book is still available.

The location of the estate record in the Will Book, Page 171, suggests that the death of Thomas occurred in the early 1720's, at age 70 or 75 if we assume he was born (around) 1650.

There is no other known record of Thomas.

4. JOHN4 TRAMMELL, SR. (THOMAS3, PHILLIP2, THOMAS1) was born February 15, 1674/75 in Stafford County, Virginia, and died Abt. 1755 in Falls Church, Fairfax County, Virginia. He married MARY ANN HUTT September 19, 1698 in Westmoreland County, Virginia, daughter of GERRARD HUTT and ANN HULL. She was born Aft. 1681 in Virginia, and died Aft. 1705.

Notes for JOHN TRAMMELL, SR.:

John Trammell appears in the records of Stafford County, Virginia, in the late 1690's.

He was a constable and sub-sheriff in Westmoreland, Stafford County, Virginia

Since he appears in the records about 23 years after his father Thomas obtained his freedom, we suppose that Thomas married about the time he was liberated or before and had a son John born about 1676, possibly earlier. In 1694, he was Constable and sub-Sheriff in Westmoreland, Stafford County, Virginia.

He married a French woman named Mary Gerrard Hutt..

John was of legal age and married in 1698, as indicated by this entry in Westmoreland County, Virginia, Book 2, Page 177, dated Oct. 26, 1698: "John Trammell of lower Mackotick, Cople Parish, Westmoreland County, and Mary his wife, sell to John Gardner land in Stafford and Westmoreland County . . . a part of a tract of land devised to said John Trammell by John Williams, deceased."

This record suggests that John's mother was (might have been) a daughter of this John Williams, or else the wife of John may have been the daughter of John Williams, there is no proof that either possibility is true, but both appear to be reasonable assumptions. (Boddie, in Historical Southern Families, Vol. 1, p227, mentions a land sale by John Trammell in 1691.)

There are several records of land transactions by John Trammell during the next several years, to 1705. The records for the period 1709 to 1729 were destroyed by fire during the Civil War, and we lose sight of the Trammells for a time.

He inherited land from his grandfather John Williams and lived in Westmoreland County, Virginia Four brothers - John, Sampson, Gerrard, and William owned large tracts of land in and around Falls Church, Fairfax County, Virginia.

On 20 March, 1746, by deed of record in Fairfax Courthouse, John Trammell transferred by deed to the Vestry of Truro Parish in Fairfax County a certain parcel of land containing "two acres where the upper church is to be laid off in such a manner as the Vestry shall think proper, to include said church, church yard, spring, and all appurtenances to the said premises."

John Trammell received fifty shillings sterling for the land.

The contract awarded on 9 June, 1753, is the earliest record concerning the building at Falls Church. By order of the Vestry dated 13 October, 1754, John Trammell was paid 320 pounds of tobacco "for grubbing a place for the

church."

Notes for JOHN TRAMMELL, JR.:

In 1733 a John Trammell with wife Susanna appears in the records, and we have him until he makes a Will in 1753 (probated in 1755), in which his children are listed.

1753 & 1755, Will written in Fairfax, VA. Abstracts dated 9 Apr 1753-20 May 1755 in Will Book 1742-1801 Book B p 11.

In his will he mentioned his ownership of land that he "purchased of John Harle," whom I assume to be his father-in-law.

All three sons moved to Loudoun County, Virginia. In 1766 John Trammell of Loudoun County deeded to William of Loudoun County the original land taken up by John Jarl (?) of Stafford County by patent in 1728 and devised by John Trammell, Sr., to John Trammell, Jr., his son.

William (m. Lewis) and Capt. Sampson Trammell listed in book GLEANING FROM VA. HISTORY as being in American Revolution in battle of Stone Mountain, North Carolina.

The Georgia Trammells came down from Virginia into North Carolina and South Carolina then into the territory that is now Lincoln County that was included in the lands ceded by the Creek and Cherokee Indians in 1773 from which Wilkes County was later created. Lincoln County was created Feb. 20, 1796 and contains 291 square miles. It was taken exclusively from Wilkes County, Georgia.

He was born ca 1702 (Fairfax County, Virginia land records of land standing, Page 256) and died near Falls Church in 1786.

He was appointed constable and surveyor of roads in 1754 in Fairfax County, Virginia.

His Will, dated 16 November, 1786 (Fairfax County Will Book E, #I, Page 148) mentions his wife Mary and eight children.

He also mentions a grandson Gerrard Trammell who he left his "still and warm pone mash."

Colonel James Wren furnished a burial sheet.

An inventory of his estate was made 16 December, 1786 by Charles Broadwater and Thomas Gunnell.

Gerrard Trammell was Sexton at the meeting of the Vestry held 12 November, 1759.

At the meeting of the Vestry held 3 October, 1763, Gerrard Trammell was Sexton of the church and also acted as constable.

He served as Sexton from 1767 to 1776.

Military Records: 1770s: Captain Sampson Trammell, Stone Mountain, North Carolina
On the 12 January, 1764 meeting, it was ordered by the Fairfax Court that Sampson Trammell, William Trammell, William Noding, and Hugh Conn "view the most convenient way for a road to be opened.."
In 1784, Sampson Trammell was living two miles West of Falls Church, and there George Washington and Doctor Craik stopped on their way to Washington's western land.

George Washington, in his diary, specifically mentioned having stopped at the plantation of his friend, Sampson Trammell. Sampson Trammell is listed as Captain in Paulajo Menke's information.

Mil. Rec. 1770's, Capt. Sampson Trammell, Stone Mountain, North Carolina. 1784: resided two miles west of Falls Church, Fairfax County, Virginia. George Washington and Dr. Craik were entertained there with dinner enroute to Washington's western lands.

From FALLS CHURCH BY FENCE AND FIRESIDE, by Steadman: "There are numerous descendants of the Trammell family in Falls Church. A recent member of the family was James Philip Trammell (Mar. 31, 1843-Sep. 18, 1812) who is buried beside his wife, Elizabeth (May 19, 1850-Dec. 16, 1929) in Oakwood Cemetery"

1808: Sons David, Philip, and Garrot (sie) petition Congress for Indian Territory. The area later became part of Randolph County, Illinois He was part of the U.S. Troop of the Great Territory of "Northwest of the Ohio."

1775: Began military service, Major, US Troop of the Great Territory of "Northwest of the Ohio."

After the Revolutionary War, he led the Trammells and allied families into the newly established territories, ending in Illinois.

By 1810, six Trammell families were enumerated in the Illinois Territory.

John was of legal age and married in 1698, as indicated by this entry in Westmoreland County, Virginia, Book 2, Page 177, dated Oct. 26, 1698: "John Trammell of lower Mackotick, Cople Parish, Westmoreland County, and Mary his wife, sell to John Gardner land in Stafford and Westmoreland County... a part of a tract of land devised to said John Trammell by John Williams, deceased." This record suggests that John's mother was (might have been) a daughter of this John Williams, or else the wife of John may have been the daughter of John Williams. there is no proof that either possibility is true, but both appear to be reasonable assumptions. (Boddie, in Historical Southern Families, Vol. 1, p227, mentions a land sale by John Trammell in 1691.)

There are several records of land transactions by John Trammell during the next several years, to 1705. The records for the period 1709 to 1729 were destroyed by fire during the Civil War, and we lose sight of the Trammells for a time.

He inherited land from his grandfather John Williams and lived in Westmoreland County, Virginia

Four brothers - John, Sampson, Gerrard, and William owned large tracts of land in and around Falls Church, Fairfax County, Virginia

On 20 March, 1746, by deed of record in Fairfax Courthouse, John Trammell transferred by deed to the Vestry of Truro Parish in Fairfax County a certain parcel of land containing "two acres where the upper church is to be laid off in such a manner as the Vestry shall think proper, to include said church, church yard, spring, and all appurtenances to the said premises."

John Trammell received fifty shillings sterling for the land.

The contract awarded on 9 June, 1753, is the earliest record concerning the building at Falls Church. By order of the Vestry dated 13 October, 1754, John Trammell was paid 320 pounds of tobacco "for grubbing a place for the church."

In his will he mentioned his ownership of land that he "purchased of John Harle," whom I assume to be his father-in-law.

All three sons moved to Loudoun County, Virginia. In 1766 John Trammell of Loudoun County deeded to William of Loudoun County the original land taken up by John Jarl (?) of Stafford County by patent in 1728 and devised by John Trammell, Sr., to John Trammell, Jr., his son.

Notes for THOMAS TRAMMELL:

In the spring of 1671 Thomas sailed from Bristol, England to America.

He signed an agreement 5 March, 1674/75 to work for 4 years for Francis Wyeth.

At the end of that time, he was given 50 acres of land in the colony.

He eventually owned plantations in St Paul's and Overwharton Parishes, both in Stafford County.

At that time, tobacco was brought to the Stafford ports for export.

Thomas died 1720/21.

His estate in Stafford County was probated in 1725/26

In the Minutes of the Council of the General Court of Virginia, dated March 5, 1674/75, page 405, is this entry: "Upon oath of Captain Moore that Thomas Trammell came to this country but for four years - It is ordered that he be acquitted from service and that Mr. Francis Wyeth, his master, do pay him coin (corn?) and clothes according to custom and costs".

Thomas settled in Stafford County, Virginia, and died there, as indicated by his estate record shown by the Index book to be in Will Book 1721-1730 (1750?), page 171.

The Will Book is lost but the Index Book is still available.

The location of the estate record in the Will Book, Page 171, suggests that the death of Thomas occurred in the early 1720's, at age 70 or 75 if we assume he was born (around) 1650.

There is no other known record of Thomas.



In Memory of Ruby Trammell Lester 1912-2004 Ann Barrow Harris

I was in early Middle School when my last grand parent died. Throughout my early adult life, I always felt a twinge of envy of those of my friends that were fortunate enough to have grandparents. Even though I never really knew much about mine, I knew that I was missing out on so much wisdom, companionship and history.

After several years, Ruby and I reconnected, I and was blessed to spend many years catching up on so much of the Trammell/Barrow history. I also gained a wonderful friend, and she agreed that I could call her "my grandmother"! Now, I had that grandparent for which I had longed!

Ruby was the youngest child of Ma and Pa Trammell and was the sister of my paternal grandmother, Virginia (Gingoo). As I sat in her ICU room, watching her on life support, I reflected on three specific blessings that God had granted me:

- The blessing of her history- It was such a blessing to be able to hear about my great grand parents (Trammells). Ruby grew up on a farm in Alabama. Her father was a farmer and her mother raised 10 children! Ruby remembered eating good, fresh farm food, helping her mother with chores, and how hard her parents worked from sun-up to sun down. She told me several stories..one was how she remembered watching Gingoo as she sang in the church choir and how beautiful she looked...she idolized Gingoo and wanted to look just like her! She also told me about when Bill, my father, was a very young boy and how much he loved to stay with Ma and Pa. She said that once his parents (Pop and Gingoo) had tried to take him home and he cried and cried. Pop finally relented and they allowed Bill to stay on. Imagine the kind heart of Ma as she added Bill into the fold of her other 10 children. Ruby stated that Bill would run and play outside until he was parched with thirst, and run into the house yelling, "Ma, I need some water". She would get him his water, and, as he was about to run out of the door, Ma would say, "Billy, give me a hug"...and Bill would grab her neck, hug it, and run out into his world again. Ruby also told me about the sadness she experienced when, as a young teenager, she lost both of her parents within weeks of each other. She was forced to go to Atlanta to live with her brother for a while, and then she had to find work. As the years went on, she ended up serving as a very successful book keeper with a Lumber company in East Point. She married and buried two husbands. She lived alone, drove her own car, managed her finances, and took care of herself up until she was 92. She was a self-made woman-a true renaissance woman of her time! What a role model for women! I will miss learning from her!
- 2. The blessing of her companionship-It was obvious that for a woman of 92, Ruby had it together! She took care of herself, down to driving to her hair dresser every week! Her doctors were amazed at her good health, and she could address any current issue that had been on the news the night before. She understood that the world was really changing and felt that God had a plan that He was putting in to place. When we would go to get Bar-B-Que, she would tell me about what was going on in her neighborhood, who was moving and to where, and who was helping her with her garbage, yard, and odd jobs. Going to lunch with Ruby was atypical of what one might thing it would be. With very little assistance, she could maneuver into even the highest SUV and enjoyed riding around and looking for antique shops. I adored catching up with her, and letting her tell me more stories about my family. I will so miss that wonderful companionship!
- Finally, I am most thankful for a merciful and loving God who, by His promises (that He always keeps) and grace, will allow us all to see her again in her perfect body, in a most perfect place.



A great-great-great soldier

Honoring a Revolutionary War soldier

After being unmarked for years, great-great-great grandson, Hugh Barrow, and family placed a Veteran's Administration marble marker in honor of Barrow's great-great-great grandfather, Thomas Trammell, a Revolutionary War soldier.

"For many years I have tried to locate the burial sites of a number of my ancestors, including that of Thomas Trammell. Growing up, I did not hear about my great-great-great grandfather. I did know that he was a Revolutionary War soldier and did find out in what units he served. I only discovered where he was buried last year. I had some information that he died in Pike County, but did not know that it would now be Upson," Barrow said.

Trammell was born in 1747 in one of the Carolinas. When he was 33-years-old he lived in South Carolina, and he enlisted as a private in Captain Hughes' Company of Colonel Thomas Brandon's calvary unit of "Carolina Horsemen."

"His great grandfather, another Thomas, came to America in 1670 and settled in Stafford County, Va. His grandfather and father also lived in Stafford County. His father moved to North Carolina and then to the Ninety Six District, South Carolina (east of Spartanburg), before the Revolution," Barrow said. "We do not know if Thomas, the Revolutionary War soldier, was born in Virginia, North Carolina or South Carolina, but we do have records that he was born in 1747. He married Mary Turner in South Carolina before the war. He died at his home in Pike Co. in 1823. He was evidently a fairly prosperous farmer at this time, and I wonder why his grave was not marked."

Trammell is buried in the Antioch United Methodist Church Cemetery which is located in Upson Co.

"His wife Mary and his sons drew land in Alabama that was ceded to the United States by the Creek Indian treaty of 1832 and moved to this
