The Ancestry of Esther Blount (1703 - ?)

Esther Blount was born 17 Mar 1703 of Chowan, NC. She married John Worley, born 1701 in VA. John was the son of Edward Worley, born c 1673, married c 1695, and died c 1724 at York Co., Charles Parish, VA, leaving a will. John's mother was Mary Worley, born c 1677. Esther was the daughter of

John Blount, born 17 Oct 1670 VA, died 17 Mar 1725 Mulberry Hill, Chowan Co., NC, near Edenton on Albemarle Sound. Esther's mother was Elizabeth Davis, born 1679, died 1732-33 at Mulberry Hill with her husband. They married 11 June 1695 Henrico Co., VA, living on the land at Mulberry Hill that John's father James Blount had bequeathed to him. James had patented this land in 1684; however, it is probable that he occupied the land several years before he secured his grant. The court records show that James was in Shaftsbury or Chowan Precinct in 1670, probably coming there in 1669.

John and Elizabeth had ten children, six daughters and four sons. They are the progenitors of a large and influential family in NC, and many well-known names in the state trace to these children of John Blount. These children are:

- 1. Mary Blount, born 1696, married Jonathan Jacocks I. They both died @1735 at or near Scotch Hall in Bertie Co., NC.
- 2. Elizabeth Blount born 1697, married Dr. Samuel Pagett. They lived and died in Edenton, NC.
- 3. Sarah Blount, born 1699, married John Lovick, Sec. of the Colony of NC. She lived only a few years and died without children.
- 4. Martha Blount born 1702, married first Thomas West, who died in 1722, leaving two daughters, Martha West, who married Edward Bryan, of Bertie, and Elizabeth West, who married Col. Thomas Whitmell of Bertie Co., NC. Martha married second ---- Worsley.
 - 5. Esther or Hester Worley (see above)
 - 6. John Blount, born 1706, married Sarah E. Vail, daughter of Jeremiah Vail. They succeeded to the Mulberry Hill estate and lived and died there.
 - 7. Thomas Blount, born 1708, married Elizabeth Pollock, widow of Major George Pollock, and daughter of Thomas Whitmell and his wife Elizabeth Hunter Bryan. They had two children: Whitmell Blount, who married Amelia Bryan, and was probably killed at the battle of Germantown, during the Revolutionary War, and Winnifred Blount, who married her cousin Hon. Whitmey Hill. Mrs. Elizabeth

Blount married Col. William Williams of Martin County, NC, son of William Williams and his wife Elizabeth Alston, daughter of John Alston.

- 8. James Blount, born 1710, married ---- and had two daughters: Nancy Blount, who married Dempsey Connor, son of Dempsey Connor and Mary Pendleton, great-granddaughter of Gov. Archdale (NC), and left one daughter, Frances Clark Pollock Connor, who married first Joseph Blount III, and second William Hill; and Betsy Blount, who married Jeremiah Vail, son of Jeremiah Vail. They removed to New Hanover Co., NC.
- 9. Anne Blount, born 1712, married ---- Worley.
- 10. Joseph Blount, born 1716, died 1777, married Sarah Durant, daughter of George Durant (grandson of George Durant the elder) and Hagar Crisp, daughter of Nicholas Crisp and --- Wilkins. They left many children.

John Blount was the son of

James Blount, born c 1620 of Astley, Worcestershire, England, and Ann Willis, born c 1639, of Sodington, Worcestershire, England. They married 1660, of Isle of Wight, VA. Ann was the daughter of Balthazar and Hannah ---- Willis[x]. James died 1686, Chowan Co., NC, and Ann died in Ipswich, MA. James was a Captain in the Life Guards of Charles I. His is said to be the oldest NC family. A will dated 9 Jul 1685 reads:

"Son James Blount, son Thomas Blount, two daughters Ann Slocum, and Elizabeth Hawkins, grandchildren James and Sarah Blount, children of my son Thomas and Ann Slocum, daughter of my daughter Ann Slocum, John Hawkins, son of my daughter Elizabeth Hawkins, son John Blount; wife Ann Blount sole executrix. Witnesses, John Railey, Jane Miller, William Dobson."

James and his brother Thomas Blount (grandfather of William Blount, first governor of TN) came to VA together equipped with money and a family crest. Prior to that, on 13 Sept 1655, the following came to America bound to James [Blunt] to serve in Virginia: Thomas Taylor of Lugwardine, Heref, labourer, for 6 years; Rebecca Davis of Grosmont, Monmouth, spinster, for 3 years; and Anne Morgan of Rowlstone, Heref, spinster, for 3 years.

Early the Blounts moved to Chowan Precinct in present NC in search of better and cheaper lands for their tobacco plantations. James patented a tract of land there known as Mulberry Hill, a showplace home with fresh-water springs and carefully planted orchards. He was a leader in Culpepper's Rebellion, was a burgess, a member of the governor's council, and a leading citizen.

Blount land and slaves were bought, sold, and leased to work on shares. Blount mills ground the essential corn or sliced the boards of the community for cash or barter. Blount carpenters and coopers made wagons, staves, and shingles, and Blount forges served both farmers and soldiers for profit.

He died 4 May 1572, and she died after 1572. Robert was the son of

Walter Blount, born c 1487, of Astley, England, and Margaret (Isabel) Acton, born c 1491, of G---, England. She was the daughter of Walter (John) Acton (born c 1464 of G---, England) and his wife (?) (born c 1469 of G---). Margaret's parents married @ 1490 at G---. Walter and Margaret married c 1512. Walter died 3 Oct 1561 in England, and Margaret died 8 Jan, 1562, in England. Walter was the son of

Thomas Blount [Sir Knight], born 1455, of Kinlet, Shropshire, England, and Anne Croft, born c 1464, of C, England. She was the daughter of Sir Richard (born c 1432) and Elinore (Barre) Bare Croft (born c 1437). Sir Thomas and Anne married c 1480, Shropshire. He died 4 Jun 1524, and she died 27 Sep 1549. Thomas was the son of

Humphrey Blount [Sir Knight], born 1423, of Kinlet, England, and Elizabeth Winnington, born c 1428, of Cheshire, England. She and Humphrey married c 1452, in Cheshire. He died 1477, and she died after 20 Apr 1478. She was the daughter of Robert Winnington, born c 1401, of Delves, S, England, and his wife (?), born c 1406, of Delves, S, England (married c 1427, of Delves, C, England). Humphrey was the son of

John Blount [Sir Knight], born c 1385, of Kinlet, S, England, and Alice (Alicia) De La Bere, born c 1394, of Kinnerlesy, H, England, to Kynard (Kinnard) De La Bere (born c 1368 of Kinnerlesy) and Joanna ---- (born c 1373 of Kinnerlesy). Kynard and Joanna married c 1393 of County, C, England. John was the son of

John Blount [Sir Knight], born 1343, of Sodington, Worcestershire, England, and Isabel (Isabella) Cornwall, born c 1348, of Kinlet,

R Blount [Baron of Saxlingham], born c 1197, of Ixworth, S, England, and Isabel Odingsells, born c 1202, of Belton, daughter of ----Odingsells, born c 1176. Baron Blount and Isabel married c 1228, of Belton. He died 1288, the son of

Stephen Blount, born c 1166, of Ixworth, S, England, and Maria Blount, born c 1170, of Saxlington, England. She was the daughter of William Blount (born c 1149) and ---- his wife (born c 1154). Stephen and Maria married c 1196, of Saxlingham, N, England. He died in 1235, the son of

Gilbert Blount, born c 1120, of S, England, and Agnes De L'Isle, born before 1130, of Ixworth, S, England. Agnes was of Magna Carta Surety lineage (Brian de L'Isle). Gilbert and Agnes married in Ixworth. He died c 1188, and she died after 1198. He was the son of

W Blount [Baron of Ixworth], born c 1096, of Ixworth, S, England, and Sarah De Munchensy, born c 1097, of Norfolk, England. She was the daughter of M/M Hubert De Munchensy, of Normandy, France. Baron Blount and Sarah married c 1118 of Ixworth. He was the son of

G Blount [Baron of Ixworth], born c 1071, of Ixworth, and Alice De Colekirke, who lived c 1060 of Ixworth. He was the son of

Robert "The Admiral" Le Blount, born c 1029, of Guisnes, P, France, and Gundella (Gunred) G Ferrers, born c 1036, of Normandy, the daughter of M/M Walkelin De Ferrers, of Magna Carta Surety lineage (William de Ferrers). Admiral le Blount and Gundella married c

WILLIAM BARROW, b. 1727-1728 in Virginia, probably Isle of Wight area, m. AMEY LEE daughter of WILLIAM LEE. One researcher states that WILLIAM LEE was born 6-23-1683 in Isle of Wight Co., VA and that he married REBECCA BURCHETT in 1710 at age 27 years, though we have no proof or reference to this information. WILLIAM LEE made his Will in Brunswick Co., VA (Will BK 3:371) on 8-3-1759 proved 5-26-1761 with HENRY LEE as executor. Heirs were a grandson PETER LEE, a son WILLIAM LEE, four daus. ELIZABETH, ANN, REBECCA and AMY (wife of WILLIAM BARROW). PETER LEE, reputedly the grandson of WILLIAM LEE, joined with JOHN FORGASON in selling land on the "North side of FOUNTAIN'S CREEK" in Brunswick Co. to Briggs Goodrich on 2-4-1779 at which time PETER and ELIZABETH LEE were then of "Duplin Co., N.C." He also figures in deeds of Johnston Co. & Sampson Co., N.C. JOHN FORGASON married a daughter of WILLIAM BARROW whose given name we have not learned.

Several researchers have used the name "PHOEBE HILL BARROW grandaughter of JOHN BARROW who made his Will in Southampton Co.VA in 1776" as being the wife of JOHN FORGASON. PHOEBE HILL BARROW, presumably the grandaughter referred to in the Will, served as a Witness to a deed in Southampton Co. in 1783. She cannot be the one who m. JOHN FORGASON in BRUNSWICK Co., where her father lived, about 1775 and had 14 children born between 1776 and 1801. See other records in this volume, with Bible records for their children.

On 10-2-1779, WILLIAM BARROW and his wife AMEY LEE sold three tracts of land in Brunswick Co. in Meherrin Parish consisting of 88 acres received by Land Grant "on the South side" of Meherrin River, a 101 ac. tract and a 200 ac. tract, both lying on the "North side of FOUNT-AIN'S CREEK" and the "South side of Christiana Road" with one bounded by "BARROW'S SPRING BRANCH" (DB 13:378). We have not learned when AMEY died or if she made the move to North Carolina with her family soon after selling the above lands. We know that WILLIAM BARROW had married again by August 1795 when he was visited by his oldest son, REV. DAVID BARROW, while living in Stokes Co., N.C. Rev. DAVID states in his Diary "took leave of my father and mother-in-law". Another entry in the Diary states that his father lived "hard by" AARON BARROW in 1795, the youngest known son of WILLIAM and AMEY.

We know that WILLIAM BARROW owned land in <u>SALEM</u> (now WINSTON-SALEM) area of Stokes Co. at least as early as 1796 and perhaps much earlier. Stokes Co. DB 2:349 - dated 5-20-1796, FREDER. WM. MARSHALL of Salem to <u>WILLIAM BARROW</u>, <u>Planter</u>, for 73 pounds, 200 acres of the WACHOVIA FRIEDLAND SETTLEMENT...said lands adj. Fredr. Miller, Philip Schneider and William Swaim...crossing the FAYETTEVILLE ROAD...bordering CHARLES CREEK at the <u>Head Branch of MUDDY CREEK...Wit:</u> Jacob Boum, Lewis Meinung.

On 4-4-1796 (Stokes Co. DB 2:386-387) WILLIAM BARROW purchased a 10 ac. tract on MUDDY CREEK from William Swaim "in the WACHOVIA line, which may have been a Mill site as it states "on the bank of a wet piece of Meadow ground"...Wit: Joel Drawn, <u>AARON BARROW</u>.

On 8-1-1797 (Stokes Co. DB 2:399), AARON BARROW purchased 100 ac. tract from Ashley Johnson for 100 pounds "lying on the <u>waters of MUDDY CREEK"</u> adj. said Johnson, Swaim and the <u>DAN RIVER ROAD...Wit: William Swim</u>, James Johnson. Some of these lands may have been cut off into Forsyth Co. when it was formed from Stokes many years later. One WILLIAM BARROW was the first Mayor of SALEM (now Winston-Salem), an early community settled by Moravians which has now been restored, attracting thousands of visitors each year. MUDDY CREEK is shown on the early map by Collet as CHARLES CREEK in 1770. It flows from Southwest Stokes Co. into the Yadkin River. WILLIAM'S son MOSES BARROW also owned lands in Stokes Co., N. C.

WILLIAM BARROW died in Stokes Co., N. C. on 1-23-1817 at "89 years of age" (Raleigh Reg. Feb. issue 1817). He was further identified as being the "father of Rev. DAVID BARROW". His son, AARON, moved to Kentucky near his brothers, prior to 1810. By 1822, JESSE T. BARROW, one of AARON'S older sons, had married NANCY SHEPERD and was living in Adair Co., KY.

A Line of Descent from MOSES BARROW, son of THOMAS, JR., of N. C. and GA

The following submitted by Mr. Martin Chambers of Chamblee, GA:

I - HUGH MARTIN CHAMBERS, b. 3-3-1920, m. (1) KATHERINE WATKINS on 4-11-1948 in Henry Co., GA, (2) BARBARA JEAN GUNNELL BURGE on 7-4-1955 in Cobb Co., GA

II - CHLOE CORA BARROW, b. 10-11-1880 at Bowdon, Carroll Co., GA d. 1-17-1969 at Gen. Bowdon, GA, m. JOHN MARTIN CHAMBERS (b. 12-17-1878 Heard Co., GA d. 10-15-1972 at Bowdon, GA) on 12-25-1902. A year later he went to Reed, Greer Co., OK where he received a Homestead Deed of "160 acres of Indian Land in the Panhandle of the Oklahama Territory. He returned to GA in 1911 but returned to OK each year through 1914 to reap a crop of wheat". He sold this land in 1915. They had nine children. She was the dau. of:

Gen. III WILLIAM HENRY C. BARROW, b. 11-12-1842 Carroll Co., GA d. 6-10-1901 Carroll Co., GA, m. MARY ELLA HIGHT (b. 11-19-1853 d. 9-19-1924 dau. of WILLIAM BAKER HIGHT and his wife MARY E. TOLBERT) on 2-1-1874 in Carroll Co., GA. He served in the Civil War in Co. B, Cobb's Legion GA Volunteers. They had 8 children. The son of:

> JAMES BARROW (Rev.), Baptist Minister, helped establish several early churches in Georgia. He suffered from crippling arthritis, using crutches to walk. He traveled widely in his ministry, throughout GA & AL. He was born on Christmas Day, 12-25-1801 on his father's plantation in Washington Co., GA. His father died when JAMES was only 3 days old. His mother, MARTHA (often referred to as MILDRED), m. (2) CHARLES THOMPSON. She died when JAMES was aged 10 years. His Uncle JAMES BARROW was appointed his Guardian until his older brother, JACOB, became his legal Guardian a few years later. He m. LUCINDA BIVINS (b. c. 1809 prob. in Baldwin Co., GA d. 12-21-1873 in a fire accident in Carroll Co., GA) on 1-2-1825 in Milledgeville, Baldwin Co., GA (prob. at the home of his Uncle JAMES BARROW). They moved to Upson Co., then, Talbot Co., prior to settling in Carroll Co. where he d. 7-30-1884 at about 83 yrs of age. They had 7 known children. He was the son of:

MOSES BARROW, b. c. 1755 in Halifax/Edgecombe Co., area of N.C., moving to Onslow Co., NC about 1760 where his father died in 1761 and his mother died a year later. His Uncle, SOLOMON ATKINSON of Halifax Co., became his Guardian. He served in the Revolution (N.C. State Rec. Vol. XVI p 1023 and NSDAR Patriot Index p. 40). His wife appears on Deeds in Edgecombe Co., NC as MARTHA (some records show her as MILDRED) and in the records of Washington Co., GA with Letters of Administration on her husband's estate she is also listed as MARTHA BARROW (3-27-1802). See other records in these volumes. They had 5 known children who are listed in his brother JAMES' Bible. He died 12-28-1801 in Washington Co., GA. He was the son of:

THOMAS BARROW, JR., whose birth date is given by several family historians as being 1698 in Surry Co. just prior to his father moving a few miles southward on the Blackwater Swamp in Isle of Wight Co., VA. His first wife was MARY by whom he had several children, only one of whom is named in his Will in 1761. Reputedly, all the other children by wife MARY predeceased their father. MARY d. after 3-1-1751 (DB 4:45 in Halifax Co., NC) when she co-signed a deed with her husband. THOMAS, JR. then m. ELIZABETH ATKINSON by whom he had 3 sons and 1 dau. He was the son of:

THOMAS BARROW, SR. of Southampton Co., VA (formed from Isle of Wight in 1749) d. Gen. VII testate in 1763, naming his son THOMAS (JR.) whose children were to receive their father's share (See other records in these volumes). Since we know from a letter, written 9-10-1817 by Rev. DAVID BARROW of Montgomery Co., KY (a great grandson) to his cousin, JAMES BARROW in Baldwin Co., GA who entered it in his Journal, that THOMAS, SR. lived to be between 90 and 100 years old, we can then establish his birth as being between 1665 and 1670 (probably in Surry Co., VA) where his father died intestate in 1684.

Records of Rev. JAMES BARROW, son of MOSES, gr. son of THOMAS, JR., of Georgia -

The following from Mr. MARTIN CHAMBERS and from other family historians:

On the BALDWIN Co., GA tax List of 1813, we find JAMES BARROW, brother of MOSES, being taxed for his own lands in WASHINGTON & BURKE Counties and serving as GUARDIAN for the ORPHANS of MOSES BARROW who died in WASHINGTON Co. on 12-28-1801, a few years after moving from North Carolina. It reads as follows:

"JAMES BARROW - 77 Slaves - 90 ac. cultivated with 1,972 ac. in Pineland in Washington Co.

400 ac. plus 30½ in Pineland in Hancock Co. Grantee: Eilands

1500 ac. Burke County, Grantee: Mulky? (1814 shows Felds?)

482½ ac. Baldwin Co., Grantee: Catching? (or Kitchen?)

As GUARDIAN for the ORPHANS of MOSES BARROW - 7 Slaves - 260-3/4 ac. Quality

42 land plus 200 ac. Quality #3 land (Total 460-3/4 ac.) in Washington County

Grantee: Dunne & Fail?

In 1814 Tax List, MOSES BARROW'S Orphans still own the 260-3/4 ac. of Qual. # 2 land and 200 ac. Qual. #3 land but the Grantee is listed as Rilley. They still show with 7 Slaves. (Baldwin Co. Tax Bk 1:7).

Also, in this same year, we note that JAMES' 2nd wife NANCY HARDWICK DANIEL'S estate is shown with 40 slaves, 90 ac. plus 197 ac. in Baldwin Co., plus 430½ ac. Hancock Co., plus 17 other slaves with JAMES BARROW listed as "Agent" for her Estate (from her first husband JAMES DANIELS).

Louisville, GEORGIA - Wednesday, April 27, 1802 - "The Louisville Gazette and Republican Trumpet" Volume IV - No. 160 (newspaper published weekly):

"GEORGIA, WASHINGTON County, Where MARTHA BARROW and Cornelius Murphy hath this day applied to me for LETTERS of ADMINISTRATION on the ESTATE of MOSES BARROW, late of the county aforesaid, DECEASED; these are therefore to cite and admonish all and singular the kindred and creditors of the said deceased to file their objections if any they have, in my office, within the time allowed by law, otherwise LETTERS of ADMINISTRATION will be granted them. Given under my hand this 27th day of MARCH 1802, and in the 26th year of American Independence. J. Watts, C.C.O."

With so few records available from early Washington Co., GA, this is a very important record of MARTHA, widow of MOSES. Her name was not MILDRED as has been suggested by some researchers. We have not learned if MOSES may have been married prior to his marriage to MARTHA, nor do we have evidence that her maiden name was POWELL, as has also been suggested. She may have been closely related to the DREW SMITH family as she used DREW as the second name for one child and SMITH as the second name for another child. One Census shows MOSES BARROW with several small children in his household who could not have been those children who were born between 1792 and 1801. We speculated that they may have been the children of his brother JACOB BARROW of Halifax Co., NC who was deceased just prior to the 1790 Census being recorded. See a deed in Halifax Co., NC in which Mrs. MILLEY BARROW (widow of JACOB) co-signs with MOSES BARROW and his wife MARTHA "where the said BARROW now lives" (12-26-1795). MOSES named a son JACOB for his deceased brother. The son JACOB and the twins of MOSES and MARTHA named WILLIAM and MARY DREW BARROW were all born in HALIFAX Co., NC prior to the move to GA.

In the July 23rd issue (1802) of the "LOUISVILLE GAZETTE and Republican Trumpet" we find CHARLES THOMPSON (whom MARTHA married when widowed) and JAMES BARROW (brother of MOSES) as the ADMINISTRATORS of the estate of MOSES BARROW, advertising for sale on "Friday, the 6th day of August next onthe plantation of the late MOSES BARROW...all the STOCK, HOUSE FURNITURE and PLANTATION TOOLS" with the date the advertisement was written being 6-24-1802. Presumably, MARTHA had married CHARLES THOMPSON prior to 6-24-1802. She died when her son JAMES was about 10 years of age, which would have been about 1811-1812 as he was born on 12-25-1801. On 8-22-1814 ("GEORGIA JOURNAL" Vol. V No. 44 publ. 8-24-1814 at MILLEDGVILLE), we find JAMES BARROW, guardian, applying to the Inferior Court of WASHINGTON Co. "for leave to sell 462-3/4 acres of Tand...on KEGG CREEK, adjoining Pinson, whitaker and others; sold for the benefit of the HEIRS and creditors of MOSES BARROW, deceased" (by which time MARTHA was also deceased).



NOTES and QUESTIONS -- The 1840 U. S. cencus of Talbot County, Ga. shows James Barrow with these siblings. MALES: 1 under 5 -- 1 age 5/10 -- 1 age 40/50. The one age 5/10 would be John T. Barrow, but who was the other boy and what became of him? -- FEMALES: -- 1 under 5 -- 2 age 5/10 -- 2 age 10/15 -- 1 age 40/50. Who was the 5th girl and what became of her? -- (Rev. James Barrow moved to Carroll County, Ga. in 1842 and was instrumental in the establishment of EDEN Baptist Church, near the town of Bowdon. It was the first Baptist Church in the western part of the county). Prior to finding the will of James R. Barrow, dated 10 June 1880, and recorded at Carrollton, Carroll County, Ga., I did not know the names of William H.C. Barrows' brothers and sisters. In his will he names four of his sisters and used their married surnames. He also named his "deceased brother", John T. Barrow, and appointed his other brother, William H. Barrow, as "guardian of my son John William Barrow". -- (J.W. "Willie" Barrow was his only living child.) The birth dates of these five he named, and I have enumerated, are from U.S. cencus records and may not be the exact year of their birth, but probably are close. -- If their year of birth is correct, then their county of birth is also correct because tax records of Upson and Talbot Counties, Ga. show Rev. James Barrow lived there in those years. The marriage dates are from Carroll County, Ga. marriage records at Carrollton, and are correct.

Of special interest is: -- Two daughters and one son of Rev. James Barrow married two sons and one daughter of Cabrel and Nancy Smith, who lived just north of the town of Bowdon, making their offsprings triple first cousins.




