The second Hampton (APA-115) was launched 25 August 1944 under Maritime Commission contract by Ingalls Shipbuilding Corp., Pascagoula, Mississippi; sponsored by Mrs. Harry

Gilmore; and commissioned 17 February 1945, Comdr. W.H. Ferguson in command.

After completing her shakedown training out of Galveston, Hampton arrived Newport 20 March for duty as a training ship for pre-commissioning crews. She continued this vital duty until departing 7 May for Norfolk to embark troops destined for Hawaii. The transport sailed 19 May and arrived Pearl Harbor via the Panama Canal 9 June. At Hawaii Hampton embarked over 1,000 members of the 34th Construction Battalion and sailed for Guam, where she arrived 6 July 1945. After disembarking her Seabees, so vital to the success of the island campaign in the Pacific, the transport sailed to the east, arriving San Francisco 25 July.

Hampton sailed from San Francisco 13 August just prior to the surrender of Japan, and arrived Samar Island fleet carrying occupation forces to Japan, Hampton landed troops at Aomori Bay, Honshu, 25 September, and then returned to Okinawa for more occupation units. During October she carried these troops to Jinsen, Korea; Chefoo and Tsingtao, China, helping

to speed occupation of these ports and stabilize the volatile China situation.

Hampton departed Tsingtao for Portland, via Okinawa and Leyte, arriving 28 October 1945. She then made two voyages to Guam as part of the "Magic Carpet" fleet, performing the giant task of bringing home the thousands of Pacific veterans. After returning to the Pacific coast from the second voyage 10 February 1946, the transport sailed for the East Coast, arriving Norfolk 7 March.

Hampton decommissioned 30 April 1946 and was returned to the Maritime Commission 1 May.

In 1947 Hampton was sold to Pope and Talbot Lines and renamed P.&T. Explorer.

My dear Mr. Barrow:

I have addressed this letter to reach you after all the formalities of your separation from active service are completed. I have done so because, without formality but as clearly as I know how to say it, I want the Navy's pride in you, which it is my privilege to express, to reach into your civil life and to remain with you always.

You have served in the greatest Navy in the world.

It crushed two enemy fleets at once, receiving their surrenders only four months apart.

It brought our land-based airpower within bombing range of the enemy, and set our ground armies on the beachheads of final victory.

It performed the multitude of tasks necessary to support these military operations.

No other Navy at any time has done so much. For your part in these achievements you deserve to be proud as long as you live. The Nation which you served at a time of crisis will remember you with gratitude.

The best wishes of the Navy go with you into your future life. Good luck!

26 - A Tribute To Our Veterans 2011 - Friday, November 11, 2011

HUGH W. (BILL) BARROW



Seventeen-year-old Bill joined the navy shortly after graduating from Bowdon High School in 1943. He served aboard an Attract Transport in the Pacific. The ship was built by the Ingals Ship Yard in Pascagoula, MS. It could transport about 1,500 troops with their equipment such as trucks, their rations and supplies for a good period and the landing crafts which could transport them up onto the beach and could serve as a hospital when needed. The ship landed Seebees at Ulithi and the army at Layte and Okinawa. At the end of the war we were at

Samar in the Philippines and had loaded troops, a National Guard Unit from South Georgia of the 81 st or Wild Cat Division, for some unknown destination. We all thought it might be for the invasion of Japan or for some location nearer there. We got underway immediately and landed these Georgians at Amori, the northern most point on the major Japanese island of Honshu, shortly after the surrender. As soon as these were all landed, we returned to Okinawa, where we road out a terrible typhoon, and loaded Marines and landed them at Chefoo, China. We then collected "high point" sailors and marines from Chefoo and Tsingto, China and Korea and sailed for Portland, Oregon and were the first ship to arrive there with returning men. The people there gave us a great reception. The restaurants in the city even gave us free meals. We th~n.'made three fast trips to Guam bringing our men home. Finally a leisurely trip, with about half of the crew aboard, back through the Panama Canal to Norfolk where the ship was decommissioned. I was a member of the crew every day it was a commissioned naval vessel and was a Watertender 2/C in the Engineering Division with the title of "Oil King."

United States Navy World War II Hugh W. "Bill" Barrow

In 1943, Bill enlisted in the United States Navy when he was 17 years old and just out of Bowdon High School. He served in the Pacific aboard the USS Hampton, APA 115, as a Water Tender 2/C and as the ship's "Oil King". The Hampton was a fast troop transport which carried about 20 landing crafts (Higgins boat types) which were used to land personnel on the beaches, and, also, the ship served as a hospital for evacuating casualties. The Hampton won battle stars for The Philippine Liberation and The Okinawa campaign.

Bill served for almost three years and then four years in the Navy Reserve. Campaign medals he was awarded were: American Theater, Asiatic Campaign, Philippine Liberation, China Cruise, Occupational (Japan and Korea), WWII Victory and the Good Conduct.

Bill jokes that he went through several battles and never got to see any of the action because his battle station was below the waterline in the engine-boiler room keeping the ship running. (He was able to slip top-side occasionally to see just what was going on.)

Bill was rewarded for his service in the Navy by the U. S. Government and its people with the "G. I. Bill" that allowed him to go to college and become a chemical engineer with the DuPont Company for forty years. Thanks, America, for looking after your servicemen, especially this one!



The young couple will be at home to their many friends in Bowdon.




